#### NEPTUNE NOW ACTIVE

As pointed out in lesson No. 142 stocks are ruled by Neptune, and all the important steps so far taken toward world peace have been indicated in the Neptune Cycle Chart. Not until Neptune was within an orb of one degree of the Inconjunct aspect to the place it held in the Neptune Cycle Chart was

the way open for Ramsey MacDonald to visit America in behalf of world peace. The same influence also precipitated the long overdue slump in the stock market.

It is hopeful, as well as significant, that Neptune is the dominant planet in MacDonald's chart, being on the cusp of the 10th. It is fitting, therefore, that he should initiate, and do much to carry forward, the movement so clearly shown in the Neptune Cycle. Neptune is gradually approaching the inconjunct with its place in its cycle chart, and at the time the limitation of armament conference will meet in London, the first of the year, the aspect will be practically perfect.

Neptune is not the only planet having an influence at this time, and MacDonald is not the only statesman to be considered. Yet MacDonald has the decanate of Rulership rising, and Neptune is now in the decanate of Achievement. We may be sure, therefore, that Neptune, working through MacDonald, will do what is humanly possible to bring about a real reduction in armament and world peace.

Furthermore, he will be assisted loyally in this work by President Hoover, who has striking aspects from both Mercury and the Moon to Neptune. Already, in the QUARTERLY for Sept. 1928, under the caption, THIRD DECANATE OF LIBRA, The Brotherhood of Light has expressed its views on war. World peace is a tenet of The Religion of the Stars. Let us hasten the day!

#### WHEN DO WE MARRY?

(B. of L. Astrological Report No. 3)

The following report is based upon the major progressed aspects in the birth-charts of people at the time of their marriage. The analysis here presented was made by the Monday evening class of The Brotherhood of Light in Los Angeles during the summer and autumn of 1929.

Major directions are those aspects formed by the progression of the planets through the zodiac that release energy at the rate of one day being equivalent to one year, and two hours being equivalent to one month, in the life of man.

While the stronger progressed aspects undoubtedly have an effect when within an orb of 1 1/2 degrees of perfect, we have not considered them of sufficient influence for our purpose here unless within one degree of perfect. In these tables no aspect is included having an orb greater than one degree.

Furthermore, we have done no tampering with the time of birth, and we have included all charts received to date in which the time of day of birth is approximately known, and in which the date of marriage is stated. The charts have been erected for the time of day as stated by the person giving the information, have not been juggled or rectified, and the original data sheet furnished by our informant is on file in our office. The results, therefore, are practical; such as are obtained in the ordinary run of astrological practice.

#### MAJOR DIRECTIONS OF MARRIAGE

NOTE: We do not consider the aspects of the progressed Moon as important enough in themselves to produce marriage. Nor have we found it neces-

sary to progress the signs on the houses, or to use the aspects made by the Progressed Ascendant or Progressed M. C.

Out of 215 marriages all are shown by a major direction to the ruler or co-ruler of the 7th with one exception. This individual states that he may very well have been born 16 minutes earlier, in which case the ruler of the 7th would have been progressed to a square of the Asc.r. We do not feel justified, however, in rectifying the time to suit our convenience.

Venus was semi-sextile Uranus P., and Sun was semi-square Venus p. by major direction, and the ruler of the 7th was making, at the time, three strong Minor Directions. The marriage occurred after only ten days acquaintance, and was brief in duration, a second marriage occurring within two and a half years. I believe the Minor Directions of the ruler of the 7th (Mars) are sufficient to account for this apparent exception.

In judging vocation from a natal chart the volume of energy received from each planet, as shown by house positions and aspects, must be estimated. There is, therefore, the personal equation of the astrologer to be considered. But in tabulating major progressed directions when a definite orb of not over one degree is stated, the personal equation is eliminated, and mathematical certainty obtained.

The tables are self-explanatory, and can be used to estimate the probable influence on marriage of any particular aspect of any particular planet to the ruler of the 7th, or as a contributing influence. They do not indicate that a person will marry just because he has a major direction to the ruler of the 7th, but they do indicate that the chances are 215 to 1 that he will not marry until he has a major direction to the ruler of the 7th.

This information is valuable in two ways. It often will enable an astrologer to decide a person will not marry during a certain period. And in finding which of two rising signs is the correct one when the time of birth is not known with precision, if one sign rising gives a major direction to the ruler of the 7th at the time of marriage and the other does not, the one that gives the progressed aspect for marriage may be given the preference.

Apparently the progressed Moon may be in any house, and may, or may not, be making an aspect at the time of marriage.
