MARS CYCLE

We had intended to give the map of the new Mars Cycle. The new planet has crowded it out of this issue, but it will appear with comments in the next. Here is the data for erecting it—April 27, 1930, 11:04 P. M. Washington, D. C. L. M. T.

THE NEW PLANET

Our mathematical friend, Magnus Jensen, has prepared, and will publish shortly, a map and table of a large number of fixed stars so arranged as to be easily used for astrological purposes. From this map the position of the new planet discovered at the Lowell Observatory, Flagstaff, Arizona, is immediately apparent. Its position on March 12, 1930, according to Mr. Jensen, is zodiacal longitude Cancer 17 degrees, 34 minutes.

How fast it moves through the zodiac is not known at the time this is written. Possibly about a degree a year, as a rough guess. As soon as the astronomers chart its movement, the data will be published in this Quarterly, so that each student may insert it in birth-charts and calculate the progressed aspects to it, with a view of discovering its influence.

If the ancients were right about the influence of this tenth planet of our chain, it exerts a mediumistic force similar to that of the Moon, only of a more refined nature. Moving out from the Sun, Mercury is the first planet, and Uranus, first discovered modern planet, is the octave influence of it. The next planet out from the sun is Venus, and Neptune, the second new planet to be discovered, is an octave expression of Venus. If this system continues, the third discovered new planet—the one just discovered—should have an influence that is an octave expression of the earth—the influence of which is reflected by the Moon.

If this be the case, it has a pronounced influence upon the mind in its subtler phases, particularly influencing the ability to converse through voluntary thought transference with beings upon the inner planes of life. Undoubtedly it has much to do with spiritual aspirations. All this, however, is speculation. Its actual influence will be determined shortly by its observed effect in the lives of people whose birth-charts, and dates of events in their lives, are known.

WHEN DO PEOPLE DIE?

(Brotherhood of Light Astrological Report No. 4)

The following report is based upon the major progressed aspects in the birth-charts of people at the time of their death. The analysis here presented was made by the Monday evening class of The Brotherhood of Light in Los Angeles during the winter of 1929-30.

In these tables no aspect is included having an orb greater than one degree. No tampering with the time of birth furnished has been done, and all charts received to date have been included. The results, therefore, are practical; such as are obtained in the ordinary run of astrological practice. That our work may at any time be checked as to accuracy both the original data sheet furnished by informant, and the birth-chart with progressions worked out, in each case are kept on file in our office.

Note: Aspects made by progressed Moon are not important enough of themselves to produce death, and are not here included unless the Moon is the exclusive ruler of the 8th. Aspects of the other planets to the radical Moon, however, are included. Aspects made by progressed Asc. and M. C. are not included, but aspects to radical Asc. are included.

Note: In considering the potency of aspects and planets it should be remembered that there are twice as many semi-squares, squares, sesqui-squares and inconjuncts as there are conjunctions and oppositions; and that as only the radical place of Asc. and Moon are considered, the other planets roughly may be considered as having twice the opportunity to make progressed aspects. To compare with other planets and aspects the figures given for conjunctions and oppositions, and for Moon and Asc. should be doubled. It should also be remembered that the faster planets form progressed aspects more often, and are not necessarily more virulent because death coincides more often with their aspects.

Conclusions

These tables are self-explanatory. The first conclusion to be drawn from them is that people only die when there is a major progressed aspect to the ruler of the 8th house. The one exception noted in the tables is Chart No. 352. A child four years old died of rattlesnake bite under Sun in 6th, semi-square Uranus in 4th. Mercury, ruler of the 8th, received no major direction, but by Minor Direction Sun was trine Mercury r. In this exception, therefore, while there was no major direction to the ruler of the 8th, there was a strong influence stimulating the 8th house.

Another chart I have not listed as an exception may strictly be such. Chart No. 934, a man died from the result of a broken back. The ruler of the 8th—Mars—was afflicted by progression at the time of the accident, but he lingered for a number of years. At the time he finally died there were other severe afflictions, and a major direction from Moon to Mars, but no heavier major direction to Mars. The class concluded that as he had never recovered from the injury, but was continuously bedfast after the accident, the 8th house influence at the time of the accident should not be separated from the actual demise.

A further conclusion that may be drawn from these tables is that people only die when there are afflicting major progressed aspects. The sole exception to this is Chart No. 940. Here we have a little girl who died at the age of 2½ years, of infantile paralysis. There are three semi-sextiles by progression operative, including one to the ruler of the 8th, but no afflictions. In the radical chart, Mars is in the 6th square Saturn, and the Moon by progression has reached the square to Saturn. In this instance the major progressed Moon squaring Saturn seems to have been sufficient to indicate death.

On the other hand, it must not be assumed that a person will not die because in addition to an inharmonic aspect by progression he also has a harmonious progressed aspect. Progressed aspects have a tendency each to work out in its own terms; and more people die when they have both harmonious and inharmonic progressed aspects operative than

do when there are only inharmonic aspects present.

More people die when there are only inharmonic progressed aspects to the ruler of the 8th, but people die also when the only aspect to the ruler of the 8th is harmonious. If some severe affliction is at the time operative, even a good aspect to the ruler of the 8th is far more dangerous than no aspect to the ruler of the 8th.

Nor if a person is ill, and under very severe progressed afflictions, should we predict recovery just because the Moon by progression makes a good aspect. A glance at the table will indicate that people die when the Moon makes only good progressed aspects, and also when it makes both harmonious and inharmonic aspects. Progressed aspects map energy. Food is excellent for a hearty person, but the same food fed to one who is very ill will cause his death. Even the harmonious energies from the Moon may be too stimulating for one who is near death, and hasten the demise.

People also die when there is no progressed aspect of the Moon operative. Minor directions and heavy transits contribute often.

Needless to say, in the normal run of life progressed aspects form to the ruler of the 8th on numerous occasions. Death takes place only when, coincident with a progressed aspect to the ruler of the 8th, there are afflictions severe enough to extinguish the life forces.

Because the psychological factor may contribute to it, it is always unwise to predict the time of a person's death.

These tables serve a different purpose: They give quite positive assurance that except when the person has progressed directions to the ruler of the 8th he will not die. And they point out to him certain dangerous periods in his life during which he may have severe afflictions and at the same time progressed aspects to the ruler of the 8th.

This knowledge will enable him to take steps in two directions to secure safety. It will enable him to avoid certain environments in which the influences shown will have opportunity readily to manifest. And it will show him the kind of Mental Alchemy to apply preceding and during the period to annul the inharmonic vibrations. Taking these precautions, he will usually be able to pass safely through periods that otherwise might very readily bring his death.
