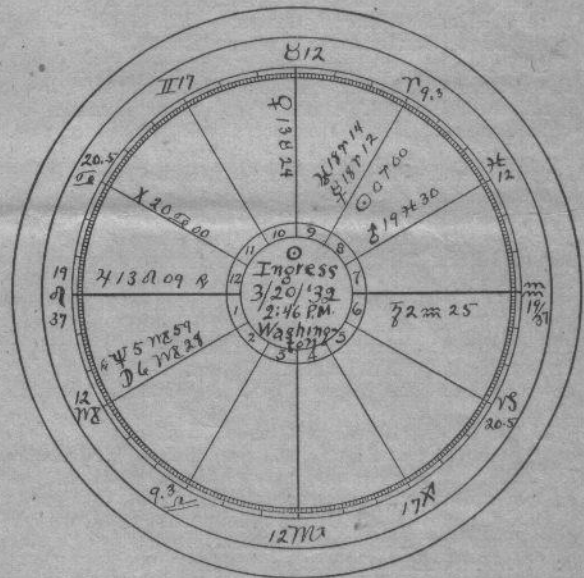
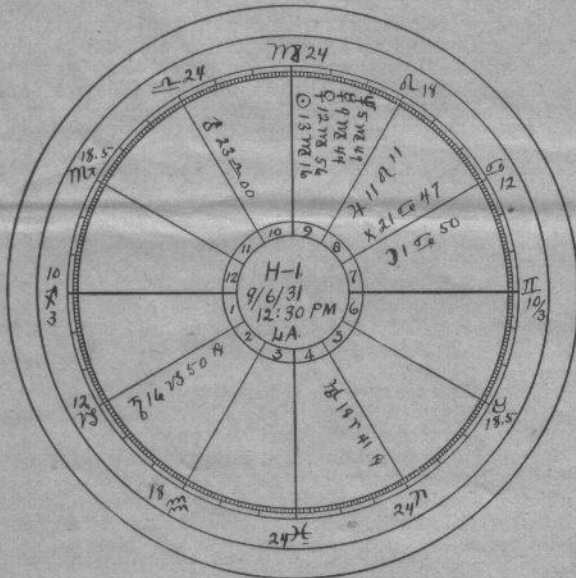

## B. OF L. EXTENSION WORK

**Horary Astrology**—Early in September the daily papers, various magazines, and radio speakers were saying that the depression was over and good times right at hand for everybody. A student, anxious to know what dependence could be placed on these reports, asked a horary question, "How will my country and its people fare the coming winter?" The question was asked Sept. 6, 1931, 12:30 P.M. Standard Time, Los Angeles; and the chart was judged by the Monday evening B. of L. astrological class on Sept. 7th. The chart is given above. As practice in horary astrology, we suggest that from the chart you write out and retain for your own use, the answers to the following questions, and verify your findings by the events of the winter. Note that the question as asked identifies the querent with his country and its people. The people, therefore, are designated by the first house.

H-1. Saturn, the planet of poverty, is in the 2nd, house of money. Do you think that money will be very hard to get this winter?

H-2. Mars, the planet of strife, is in the house of credit and business, and is opposed by Uranus, the planet of disruption, and squared by Saturn from the house of money. Do you think the government will be faced by serious financial problems, that disruption in business will necessitate radical measures to restore credit, and that many businesses will find it even harder than last winter?

H-3. Jupiter, ruler of the people, is in the house of doles, gifts, and borrowings. Do you think that either an immense loan, or a dole, will be necessary to tide the unemployed over the winter?

H-4. The Moon, coruler of the people, is in the

house of foreign countries, applying to aspects to several planets in the house of foreign commerce and the navy. Do you think that foreign countries and their navy programs will have a powerful influence upon our finances this winter?

**Mundane Astrology**—The horary chart, as the question was asked, was for the winter months only. For the year following March 20, 1932, the other chart, that of the Solar Ingress, should be used. This chart of the Sun was erected for March 20, 1932, 2:46 P.M., L.M.T., Washington.

M-21. Venus, in this Ingress Map, is in its own sign, square Jupiter, but also trine both the Moon and Neptune in the house of the people. As this favorable aspect is from the house of business, do you think that business will be better for the common people in 1932?

M-22. Neptune is the planet of socialism. It is in the house of the people, making a trine to Venus in the house of administration; while Jupiter, ruling the Republican party, afflicts Venus; and Saturn, ruling the Democratic party is also in a wide affliction to the house of ruling power. Do you think that 1932 will witness the adoption of many liberal and socialistic policies, and that the people will compel many reforms to be made?

M-12. In the Saturn Cycle, Saturn is again square Jupiter in the 9th, Aug. 15, 1931. Do you think that within a week of this date restrictions relative to shipping, or the competition of foreigners, will cause anxiety?

M-16. In the Uranian Cycle, Uranus again makes the semi-square to the Moon  $r$  in the 12th, Sept. 19, 1931. Do you think there will be another wave of prohibition agitation and crime, and plans advocated for the relief of distress?

Do you think within a week of this date there will be news of obstacles to foreign trade, and that there will be obstacles to the farmer getting a proper price for his products?

M-18. In the Jupiter Cycle, Jupiter makes the opposition to the Sun in the 2nd, house of finances, Oct. 6. Do you think that within a week of this date a serious financial situation will be disclosed?

M-19. In the Mars Cycle, Mars in the 10th reaches the opposition of the Moon Sept. 16. The 10th rules the administration. Do you think the administration will face severe difficulties, and that there will be disastrous fires and acts of violence, within three days of this date?

M-20. In the Ingress Map, the Sun reaches the opposition to Uranus  $r$ , in the 11th, Oct. 8. Do you think there will be unusual agitation for radical reforms?

Oct. 8. "Hoover Lays World Ills to Foreign Loans." Oct. 7. "German Public Rights Cut by Drastic Law." Oct. 8. "Butler Accepts Bid to Discuss Gang Law." Oct. 8. "Free Silver Cause Revived, Says Bryan Jr." Oct. 8. "Arms Cut Demanded if War Loans Slashed."

M-23. Dec. 25, in the Mars Cycle, Mars reaches the conjunction of Saturn  $r$ , in the 1st.

Do you think this Christmas will be unusually marked by hardship, crime, and violence?

M-24. Jan. 20, in the Saturn Cycle, Saturn reaches the Semi-square of the Sun  $r$ , in the 2nd, house of money.

Do you think that within a week of this date loss of money and lack of money will assume an unusual importance?

M-25. Feb. 14, in the Jupiter Cycle, Jupiter again—as it did Oct. 6—reaches the opposition of the Sun in the 2nd, house of money.

Do you think that another critical period regarding finances will be apparent within a week of this date?

M-26. Feb. 17, in the Uranian Cycle, Uranus once again comes semi-square the Sun in the 12th.

Do you think near this date there will be violent agitation for reform, agitation for beer, and much crime news?

M-27. April 26, in the Ingress Cycle here published, the Sun reaches the trine of Neptune and the Moon in the 1st.

Do you think that within a day of this date a popular demand will be shown for political policies of a socialistic nature?

As is our policy, the answers to all mundane questions will be published subsequent to the events, as quotations from Los Angeles Daily Paper Headlines.

But such quotations can convey only a glimpse of the manner in which the tides of national affairs follow the movements and aspects of the planets. Yet if you will read the daily papers for the periods covered by these questions, keeping in mind the aspect and what it influences, you will get an insight into mundane astrology that can be obtained in no other way. Keep the Quarterly handy, and watch the dates listed.

Natal Astrology—N. 9. In the progressed chart of Sir Hubert Wilkins (No. 697, published in June issue), the progressed Mars square Sun  $r$ , brought him many obstacles and great danger, and prevented his enterprise from being a success. Had Mars afflicted the Sun in the birth-chart, instead of making a sextile to it, it is likely he would never have returned.

As it was, even in a short trip under the ice, the Nautilus bent her propeller, shattered her ice drill, and gained serious leaks. The polar trip was abandoned this year, and the Nautilus is so damaged she is to be sunk.

Sir Hubert is to be congratulated on his wisdom of abandoning a bad job in time. His courage is to be admired, and another year, with better progressions in his chart, he should make a marked success of such an enterprise.

The Lindberghs—When Colonel Lindbergh and his brave little wife started on their vacation flight to the Orient, the progressed Moon in his chart had reached the conjunction of Saturn.

Delays and hindrances dogged them from the start. Fog forced them down in the sea. Their plane capsized in China. And finally a telegram reached them announcing the death of Mrs. Lindbergh's father. A vacation started under Moon conjunction Saturn by progression is not apt to be a happy one. Here's hoping the aspects are better when they set out again!

N-10. Although his progressions were better (See chart in September Quarterly), his weaker birth-chart did not permit him to defeat Virgil A. Martin.

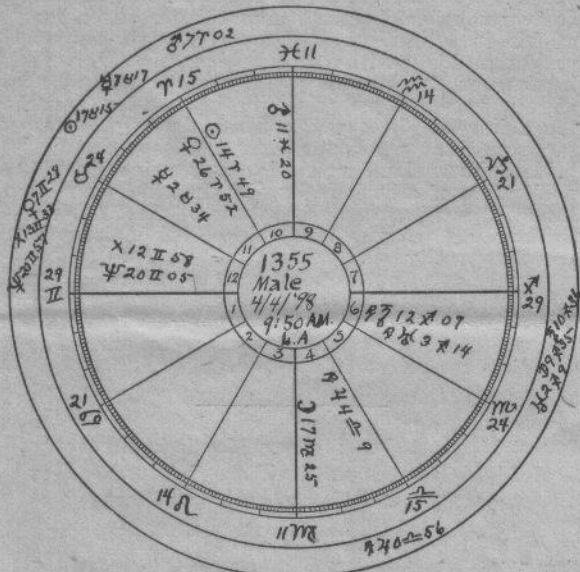
N-11. Because of his better birth-chart (See chart in September Quarterly), and in spite of adverse directions, Virgil A. Martin was able to defeat Byron Brainard.

N-12. Mr. Martin, in the primaries, received more votes than any one other candidate, but as there were a number of candidates in the field, he did not get more votes than the total received by opposing candidates.

Consequently, he was compelled to run against the strongest of these various candidates at the general election. This candidate, not Mr. Brainard,



was able to collect the votes of other opposing candidates, and after a hard fight, defeated Mr. Martin. Mr. Martin, therefore, would have saved both money and work if he had been defeated by Mr. Brainard; his success at the primaries causing him to undertake an unavailing further campaign. His adverse directions thus worked out in full.



N-13. In chart 1355, herewith published, it will be noted that there is a complete cross: Saturn is opposition Neptune and Pluto, and Mars on the M.C. is opposition the Moon, both the latter planets being square to Saturn, Neptune and Pluto. Do you think this man has ability, and that he would rise to a position of importance?

N-14. The data for this chart was furnished by his brother within two days after the event took place indicated by the progressed positions. The planets in the outer ring show the major progressed positions for May 20, 1931. Now it should be noted that the Moon is severely afflicted, especially by Mars, in the birth-chart. But at the date designated, the Sun is applying closely by progression to the trine of the Moon r. Do you think this progressed aspect brought him good fortune or misfortune?

N-15. Would the gain or loss shown by the progressed positions on this date be of permanent duration?

# WHEN DO WE TRAVEL?

**Conclusions About Travel**—In the charts analyzed in the above tables no aspect has been considered that is more than one degree from perfect. Aspects of the Moon, other than showing whether or not it makes an aspect, are considered only when the Moon is the exclusive ruler of the house. In Chart 1050, a long journey, one of three trips from New York to California and return, was made while there were exceptionally strong progressed aspects to the ruler of the 3rd, and the Moon made an aspect to the ruler of the 9th, but no heavier aspect to the ruler of the 9th. It is the one exception noted. The other two trips of this individual were shown by aspects to the 9th in the normal way. In collecting this data we have permitted the person taking the journey to designate whether it was considered short or long.

While progressed aspects to the travel planets, Mercury and Uranus, undoubtedly make travel more certain, yet the above tables indicate that no predictions for travel should be made from progressed aspects to these planets alone; for unless at the same time there is a progressed aspect to the ruler of the 3rd or 9th within one degree of perfect, the person will not travel. People make short journeys only when they are major progressed aspects to the ruler of the 3rd; and they make long journeys only when there are major progressed aspects to the ruler of the 9th.

**Astrological Help Wanted.**—In the reports so far issued, only the reverse side of progressed influences have been tabulated. That is, events of a particular character have been called for, and the progressed aspects that coincided with these events have been classified.

But of even greater value, because that is the method employed in actual astrological prediction, is the obverse side. That is, given a series of progressed aspects of a similar character, how many of them produce an event of one kind and how many of them produce an event of somewhat different type?

For instance, in the tables above are recorded 100 long journeys. It was found in 99 instances these coincided with a major progressed aspect to one of the rulers of the 9th. But the obverse, and more important, side of this is what we now want. That is, we want a series of 100 major progressed aspects to the rulers of the 9th, and a record of how many produced, during the time each aspect was within one degree of perfect, a long journey, how many caused the individual to turn to teaching, how many caused the person to publish something, and how many turned the mind noticeably to religion or philosophy.

Out of 100 progressed aspects to the ruler of the 8th, how many of them bring death into the life, how many bring a gift, and how many borrowed or loaned money? Obviously, some of us do not take a long journey every time there is a progressed

aspect to the ruler of the 9th, nor does death always accompany every progressed aspect to the ruler of our 8th.

But the number of times out of 100 that it brings one thing, and the number of times it brings some thing else, we wish to tabulate. And by studying the contributing factors, we hope to be able to formulate strict rules by which, for instance, it can be determined whether a 9th house direction will bring a journey, or will bring an experience in teaching. We hope through such studies to be able to determine, when there is a progressed aspect to any planet, which house it will operate through, and which particular thing ruled by that house it will chiefly influence.

In this work hand-picked aspects and hand-picked aspects are of no value to us. Instead, we need as complete a series as possible of major progressed aspects to the ruler of a house, including every aspect to this ruler over a period of years, giving a record of each event, if any, ruled by the house, that came into the life during the time the aspect was within one degree of perfect.

But such information can only be supplied by those with enough astrological knowledge to calculate a complete series of major progressed aspects: Will you calculate such series and record the coincident events?

Here is what we want:

**First**—We want a series of major progressed aspects to the chief ruler of any house; with a record, in each instance, of all the events ruled by such house, that transpired. If it is positive no event ruled by the house took place, that should be recorded. The progressed aspects of the Moon, due to their transitory nature, should be given in an entirely separate series.

From this we expect to build twelve tables, one covering each house, showing, on an average, how many events of one type, and how many of another ruled by each house, take place out of every 100 progressed aspects to the chief ruler of the house.

**Second**—As more advanced work, we want complete series of progressed aspects. That is, we want all the progressed aspects that occur during a period; with a record following each major aspect, showing, not merely the chief event influenced by it, but also in just what way, and to what extent, if any, each progressed aspect brought events of the nature of each house influenced by the planets involved in the aspect.

We mean that a planet may be in one house and at the same time rule the signs on the cusps of two other houses. And when an aspect forms, each of the two planets often is in a different house. Therefore, in this case, the record should show to what extent, during the time the aspect was within one degree of perfect, each of the six different houses was influenced, and in what way.

The memory is tricky when recalling the time of less important events. For such work, single events have no value to us; there must be a series completely covering a considerable period. We suggest, therefore, that you now start keeping a complete record, and in a year from now, and each subsequent year, send the record to us. This writer has kept a record in which for over thirty years he has written after each major progression during that time, just what took place. Such a record is invaluable to any person, as it gives a very fine gauge of what he may expect from other aspects of the same planets in the future.

There is a great deal of talk afloat about, "Make astrology scientific." But no real science can be formulated without extensive data. And no one person's experience is wide enough that he has



sufficient data, without the help of others, to build any science. If you want to see astrology come into its own, help us gather the necessary information. If you will contribute this, even at some cost of effort and time to yourself, we will do our part by tabulating and widely publishing the results.

If you know how to calculate a progressed chart, you can help at once. If you can erect a birth chart, but can not work progressions, get from us lessons 111, 112 and 113, and learn how. These three will be all you need for this kind of work. But if you do not know how to erect and judge a birth-chart, get Course VIII and fit yourself for a higher usefulness.

But in any event, because this is so important right now, help us gather the kind of data needed.

**Astrological Signatures.**—As this branch of astrology is devoted to ascertaining the astrological rulership of things, research concerning the rulership and influence of Pluto comes under this head.

Such responses as we have had to our request in the June Quarterly for birth-charts in which some progressed aspect to Pluto is thought to have attracted a given event, have somewhat confirmed the opinion that Pluto tends to place the individual in touch with the unseen world.

One correspondent, who has spent sixteen years popularizing astrology through periodicals, sends us the birth-data, with the comment that under the present influence of Pluto—which we find is a progressed aspect of the M. C. to Pluto—this individual turned down a very fine financial offer to do astrological writing, to assist in promulgating ideas and doctrines of a new and very popular movement. The doctrines of this movement are dictated by those of the inner planes, and are interwoven with ideas concerning life after death.

Uranus, when prominent, tends to confer clairvoyance. Neptune tends more to psychometry and the exercise of the other psychic senses. And it now seems, from considerable evidence accumulating, that Pluto tends to confer the ability to receive impressions from invisible intelligences, and governs communication by means of voluntary thought-transference with those who have passed to the next life.

Astrologers have expressed their opinion, in the various magazines, that Pluto is coruler of Scorpio. If this be the case, it explains why Scorpio, more than any other sign, inclines to occult science and the investigation of the inner planes. But, when speaking of Pluto as ruler of the underworld, we should not consider this a region of racketeers and profligates; although this may be the adverse side of it.

The tarot explains this very clearly. The unknown planet, which is now no longer unknown, is represented either by 22 or 0. As 22 it is materialism, folly and mistakes, represented by the letter T. But when the point of the T is turned up, instead of down, that which appears material folly becomes spiritual wisdom; for while 0, may have no physical value, as a circle it is the symbol of spirit. Pluto is the 22nd Major Arcanum of the tarot; which reversed, as described, is no longer 22. but the number 0.

We need birth-charts in which some progressed aspect of Pluto is thought to have attracted a given event. Unless you have Pluto accurately placed in your chart, your birth-chart is incomplete in one very important element, which may upset some of

your calculations. As Pluto moves forward nearly three degrees in some years and retrogrades nearly two degrees in others, to work progressions to Pluto with any degree of precision you need accurate monthly positions. The Ephemeris of Pluto gives the Longitude, Latitude, and Declination every thirty days from 1840 to 1940. This enables you to ascertain its place to the exact minute. What have the directions to Pluto brought you and your friends? Let us know. The price of the Ephemeris of Pluto is 75 cents.

**The Constructive Attitude.**—As assisting you to determine your own viewpoint, we wish to point out that everything treated in the 157 regular lessons already issued by The Brotherhood of Light, and everything to be mentioned in the 53 regular lessons yet to be issued to complete the 21 Courses, has some influence upon human life. In fact, the purpose of these Courses is to furnish as comprehensive information as possible about the various forces, objects, and intelligences that affect the trend of an individual's destiny.

But to furnish information on all the various influences that bear upon human life, and how these influences operate, is not the chief end toward which we work. This is merely the foundation upon which to build. From lesson No. 1, all the way through to lesson No. 210, our explanation of influences and how they affect human life is but the preliminary study that enables us to point out to you how you can avoid being influenced in ways that are undesirable to you, and how you can utilize other objects, forces and intelligences to make of your life what you want it to be.

The Brotherhood of Light Astrological Reports have the same ultimate object. In Report No. 3, our studies indicate that people marry only when certain progressed aspects are operative in their birth charts. This is interesting information, and assists in accurate predicting. But The Brotherhood of Light is interested in this report because it helps to lay the foundation for instructing people when they can make a marriage that will prove successful, and, under what conditions they should not marry to prevent domestic disaster.

Reports 5, 6, 7 and 8 have to do with death, not because we advise anyone to predict the time of death of another; but because we are completely convinced that if people knew the more dangerous periods in their lives they could be prevailed upon to take such precautions as would enable them to avoid, until old age, the advent of death. Our interest in death is not merely to find out that by progression there is always an aspect to the ruler of the 8th, and the other progressed positions shown in the Quarterly for last Christmas, but to find out how to prevent death and prolong life.

We hope we are making it clear to you that we are interested in facts because, understanding these facts, we expect to be able to show you how to have the things you desire.
