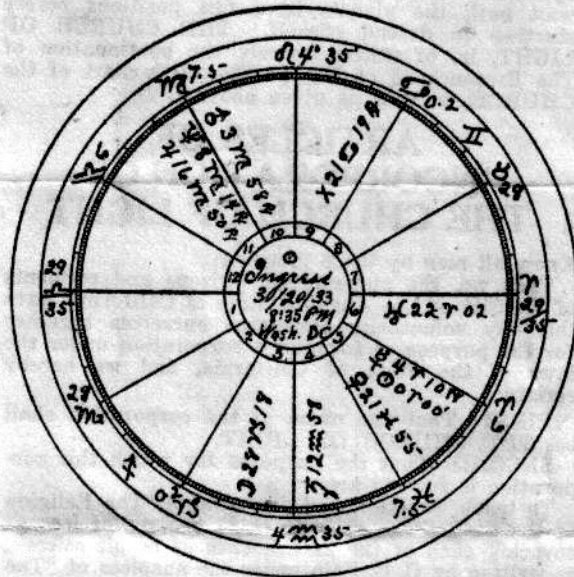
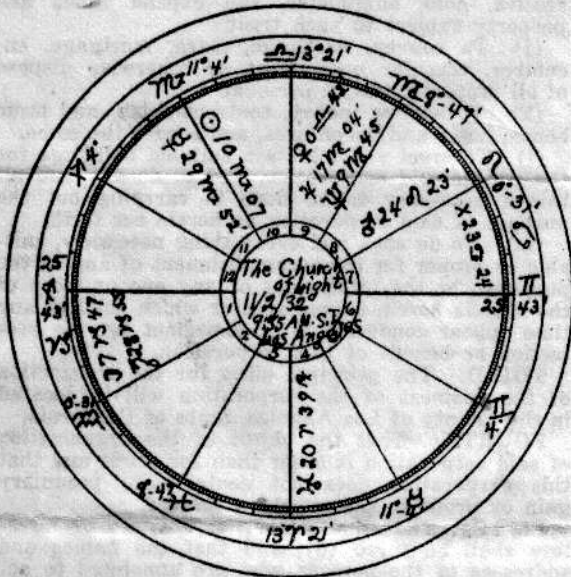

The Church of Light—In the September Quarterly I pointed out in some detail that the planet Pluto rules (in addition to having a fine spiritual side) Gangsters and Racketeers. And as Uranus rules astrology, we need not be surprised that those interested in astrology have been severely affected by the square of Uranus to Pluto.

Apr. 21, 1932, Uranus came square Pluto, and at this time a deep plot was hatched to persecute those who believe in astrology and to make the practice of astrology and any distribution of astrological literature illegal.

Sept. 3, 1932, Uranus, now retrograde, again made the square to Pluto; and under this aspect the Council of the City of Los Angeles gave the first reading to a new ordinance which was part of the plot to abolish interest in astrology.

Sept. 19, 1932, the ordinance was given its second reading, and was passed by the Council by a vote of 10 to 2.

Oct. 3, 1932, in spite of the organized protest of those in Los Angeles who are interested in astrology, the Mayor signed the ordinance and it became a law. Such a law becomes effective 30 days after publication.

According to the interpretation of the best legal talent obtainable this ordinance makes it illegal for a person to give an astrological reading free of charge even to a member of his own family; and also prohibits either the sale or free distribution of astrological books and astrological literature such as this Quarterly; provided, that nothing in this ordinance contained shall apply to any ordained or duly accredited minister of any form of religious belief, or to the faith, practice or teaching of any religious body; provided that fees, gratuities, emo-

luments or profits therefore shall be paid solely to or for the benefit of said religious body."

Various attorneys consulted advised us that our only protection against this ordinance, and similar ordinances which have been passed, or are to be passed, in other cities, is to become incorporated as a church. And within less than 24 hours after the Council had signed the ordinance we had taken steps toward the formation of such a corporation.

Jupiter was exactly conjunction Neptune on Sept. 19. Jupiter rules religion, and Neptune rules altruistic associations such as The Brotherhood of Light always has been. Furthermore, The Brotherhood of Light already was a religious organization, as set forth in The Declaration of Principles, which each member reads before signing the application for membership. This Declaration of Principles, which was issued in May, 1915, and which has been used ever since, states in no uncertain terms that The Brotherhood of Light offers a course of lessons on each of the 21 branches of occult science, and that, "They are issued with the definite purpose of reviving THE RELIGION OF THE STARS."

As a religious organization, wherever our classes and meetings have been held during the last seven-teen and a half years, these classes and meetings have always been opened and closed with a religious ceremony.

Although we are already a religious body, in view of almost certain persecution for our astrological religious beliefs, it was the unanimous opinion of the lawyers consulted that it would be far better to incorporate, and use the word CHURCH instead of BROTHERHOOD, so that no question might arise as to whether or not we are a religious organization.

That those holding astrological beliefs will be persecuted further in the near future needs only the recognition that Uranus, turning direct, again makes the square to Pluto, March 7, 1933; turns retrograde and makes the square to Pluto again Nov. 7, 1933; and then turns direct and makes the final square to Pluto in January, 1934. Astrology is ruled by Uranus, and Pluto rules racketeers: therefore, the astrologers should be prepared to defend their religious beliefs and their constitutional rights.

One would not choose to start a new organization while the T of Uranus, Saturn and Pluto is operative. Yet when war is declared, one can not wait until the planets have fine positions before starting to defend oneself. THE CHURCH OF LIGHT, is, of course, merely the continuation of The Brotherhood of Light. The birth-chart of the CHURCH, as such, is given above.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE CHURCH OF LIGHT

Know all men by these presents:

That we, the undersigned, citizens and residents of the City of Los Angeles, State of California, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of California, and we hereby certify:

FIRST: That the name of the corporation shall be, THE CHURCH OF LIGHT.

SECOND: That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

To teach, practice, and disseminate "The Religion of the Stars," as set forth in 21 courses of lessons covering each of the 21 branches of occult science, as written by C. C. Zain under the auspices of "The Brotherhood of Light," and especially

(a) To establish a church in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and to establish branch churches thereof and/or other churches throughout the world, and, in connection therewith, suitable and customary organizations for the purpose of holding religious services and ceremonies in accordance with "THE RELIGION OF THE STARS," as set forth in the 21 courses of lessons covering each of said 21 branches of occult science.

(b) To regularly and duly teach, train, qualify, elect, appoint and ordain ministers and teachers and send them forth empowered to teach "The Religion of the Stars," and to offer and to give relief to humanity from all manner of sickness and from all manner of disease, whether spiritual, mental or physical, all as under the teachings of the said "The Religion of the Stars," as set forth and comprised within the said courses of lessons mentioned.

(c) To cultivate social intercourse among its members and attendants and to assist in improving and ameliorating the spiritual, mental, moral, physical and social conditions of all its supplicants.

(d) To govern the spiritual, mental and physical welfare of the members of this corporation and the attendants of "The Church of Light," in accordance with the teachings of "The Religion of the Stars" as above mentioned.

(e) To organize and conduct classes for the purpose of disseminating knowledge pertaining to the spiritual and scientific principles involved in the accomplishment of the objects of this corporation.

(f) To publish, sell and distribute books, pamphlets, periodicals, and other literature on astrology, occultism, psychic phenomena, spiritualism, psychology, new thought, and kindred subjects, and to

manufacture and sell other supplies required by students of "The Religion of the Stars."

(g) To accumulate a fund for the relief of sick and destitute persons and other charitable purposes connected and commensurate with the aims and objects of this corporation.

(h) To receive property by devise or bequest, subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property by will, and to otherwise acquire and hold all property, real or personal, including shares of stock, bonds and securities of other corporations.

(i) To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal object of the corporation, and to receive, hold, administer, and expend funds and property subject to such trust.

(j) To convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, encumber, transfer upon trust or otherwise dispose of all property, real or personal.

(k) To borrow money, contract debts, and issue bonds, notes and debentures, and secure the same.

(l) To erect and maintain suitable buildings for the use of said corporation, and to do any and all things necessary to be done in carrying out the purpose of said corporation as herein set forth.

(m) To do each and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated or which shall at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of this corporation.

THIRD: The principal office for the transaction of the business of the corporation will be located in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

FOURTH: That the object of the organization of said corporation is other than for profit and that this corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

FIFTH: That the number of trustees or directors shall be three (3), and that the names and addresses of the persons who are appointed to act as the first trustees or directors are as follows:

SIXTH: The number of trustees or directors of the corporation may be changed by a by-law regularly adopted as may be provided in the by-laws.

SEVENTH: That by-laws may be changed or amended by a majority vote of the Board of Trustees and/or Directors.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we have hereto set our hands . . .

Advantages of The Church of Light.—The Church of Light will retain for its members such advantages as were afforded by The Brotherhood of Light, and will afford certain other advantages as follows:

1. Members will be permitted to participate in the management of the Church through the election of the trustees or directors at the annual meeting.

2. Branch churches can be established and given a legal standing.

3. Those qualified can become ordained ministers or missionary teachers empowered legally to teach "The Religion of the Stars."

4. Gifts, donations, and legacies may be made to The Church of Light, with the assurance that all such shall be used to benefit "The Religion of the Stars," being administered by a board of trustees.

5. A corporation is an entity aside from any particular individuals, being unaffected in its standing as such by the death of any of its officers. The Church of Light, therefore, is a perpetual corporation, which is independent of the welfare of some particular individual.

The new corporation starts with a net worth of

\$1,567.61. It is believed that under the present plan of management the capital will rapidly be increased by gifts and bequests, and that it will be able far better to disseminate THE RELIGION OF THE STARS than was The Brotherhood of Light.

NOTICE TO MEMBERS OF THE BROTHERHOOD OF LIGHT

We are unable legally to transfer membership in The Brotherhood of Light to THE CHURCH OF LIGHT except through such members signing a new application blank. Such a new application blank is inclosed, and we trust all who were previously members of The Brotherhood of Light will sign it, and send it in immediately for our files.

The Brotherhood of Light Annual.—There will be no future issue of The Brotherhood of Light Annual which has been published for 13 years. A separate folder will be published listing all the 210 regular B. of L. lessons embraced within the 21 courses written by C. C. Zain in which is set forth THE RELIGION OF THE STARS, which The Church of Light is empowered to teach, practice, and disseminate.

The Church of Light QUARTERLY is issued in place of the Annual, and will be published March 1, June 1, Sept. 1 and Dec. 1 of each year, commonly going to press 30 days before date of issue.

By-Laws.—As to publish the By-Laws would require more than one complete issue of the Quarterly, they have been issued, together with the Articles of Incorporation, uniform with the mimeographed B. of L. lessons, and this is listed at the end of the list of lessons on the last page of this Quarterly.

C. OF L. EXTENSION WORK

Answers to September Quarterly Questions.—

N—19. Do you think that the acceleration given to the harmonies in Mr. Roosevelt's chart about the time of election, together with the indications of the Ingress chart, will be sufficient to overcome the heavy aspects by progression in Mr. Hoover's chart, and cause Mr. Roosevelt to be elected president of the United States?

To obtain the answer to this question, instead of going to press the 1st of the month before date of issue, we have awaited until the morning of the 9th. Reports of the election this morning indicate that the promise of the Ingress chart has been fully fulfilled, and that Mr. Roosevelt has been elected president.

R—4. Would this woman be subject to inflammatory complaints? Mars angular, and closely square the Asc. tends to inflammatory complaints and fevers.

R—5. Would she be subject to diseases that would waste strength and tissue? The tendency toward such diseases is more pronounced than toward inflammatory complaints, as indicated by the Moon being in conjunction Saturn, and both square Venus in the house of illness.

R—6. At the time Mars has progressed to inconjunct the Moon r, and the Sun in the 6th has progressed to semi-square Mars r. Do you think the trine of the Sun to Neptune by progression would prevent disease, or do you think the aspects from the 6th would attract illness?

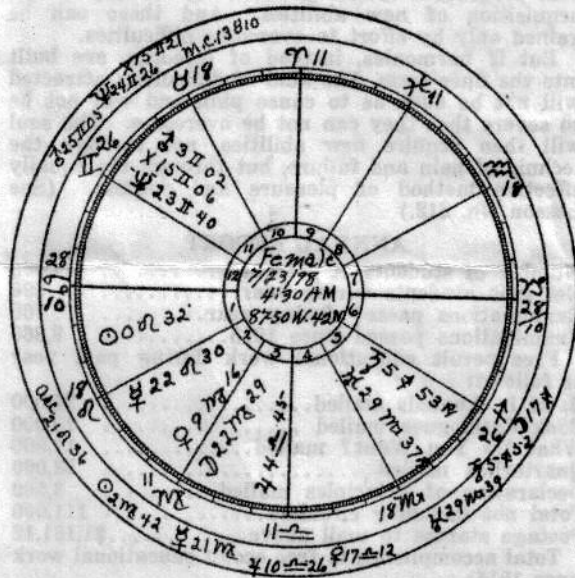
Any aspect to a planet in the 6th tends to bring illness into the life in some manner. Neptune in the birth-chart is greatly benefited by Jupiter, but severely afflicted by Uranus. Yet even a trine to Neptune seems to have little power to ward off

disease, aspects by progression to Neptune tending to make the individual more sensitive and negative than usual. And as the progressed aspect is from the 6th, it would tend to attract sickness instead of repelling it.

The affliction at the time was from Mars, therefore, the disease was of the nature of Mars, being typhoid fever. Venus in the birth chart 6th shows good care during illness, and Sun progressed to trine Neptune indicates good fortune in the kind of help received. A cure was brought about after about six weeks.

M—32. As during the autumn of 1932 Saturn is still within orb of the influence of the square of Uranus it is too much to hope for a rapid business recovery, but from July 9th on, in spite of temporary set-backs that are bound to occur, do you think the tide will be distinctly in the direction of business recovery? Up to date the indications have been so.

M—33. Now even as an afflicted Pluto influences the most pernicious form of graft and exploitation, so an afflicted Uranus tends to riots and direct action in retaliation. Do you think, therefore, that



this square between Pluto and Uranus indicates for the coming winter, troubles which are accompanied by agitation and violence?

M—35. In the Ingress chart, the Sun comes to the opposition of Mars in the 8th, Sept. 12. Do you think that within a day of this date deaths and acts of violence will assume importance?

Sept. 10: "38 Die in N. Y. River Steamer Blast; 70 Hurt." Sept. 12: "Two Killed in Crash of Ambulances." Sept. 13: "San Pedro Seamen Revolt." Sept. 11: "Forest Blaze Leaps Gorge in New Outbreak." Sept. 11: "Nine Governors Get Demand of Farm Strikers."

B—4. In the soul's education, what functions are performed by pain, obstacles and hardship?

The only possible way a soul or an individual can

develop ability is through the effort to overcome difficulties. All school training follows this plan, any lesson being such a difficulty. When one lesson is learned something has been added to the ability, and a still more difficult lesson can be attempted. (See lessons No. 212 and 213.)

B-5. Why are painful events, obstacles and hardships attracted to us?

They are attracted to us because we have within our finer bodies, as the result of experiences and thoughts in the past, certain discords. Discords within tend to attract discordant events from without.

B-6. How can we avoid attracting pain, hardship and severe obstacles?

By the proper attitude toward events we can build harmonies into our finer body which will attract harmonious events. By proper thinking we can add such rates of energy to the discords within our finer body, that these discords will be annulled, and no longer have the power to attract discords from without. (See Course IX.)

Not that we shall ever arrive at a state where there are not difficulties still to be overcome. The soul progresses eternally, and progress implies the acquisition of new abilities. And these can be gained only by effort to overcome difficulties.

But if harmonies, instead of discords, are built into the finer form. The kind of difficulties attracted will not be such as to cause pain and will not be so severe that they can not be overcome. The soul will then acquire new abilities, not through the technic of pain and failure, but through the equally effective method of pleasure and success. (See Lesson No. 212.)

Conclusions About Accidents.—In his recent book, "The Astrology of Accident," Charles E. O. Carter analyzes 168 cases of accident. The method of analysis he uses is on a different plan than the one here followed, and none of the charts used by him has been included in the above tabulated 100 charts. The data used for the charts here listed have been sent in by our students, and the progressions have been calculated by the Hermetic System.

The first thing that strikes one investigating the subject is that in the birth-charts of people who have accidents Mars, Saturn and Uranus are unusually prominent. How to determine if a planet is, or is not, prominent in a birth-chart I have discussed in earlier reports. It is a matter the judgment of which is subject to the personal equation. Nevertheless, I believe, any judgment of a birth-chart or judgment of a progression, to be of value, must take into consideration such prominence; which means the power, to influence, of the planet considered.

Mars is prominent in the charts of those who have accident more often than Uranus or Saturn. But any one of these three planets prominent tends to attract accident. When two or more of them are prominent in the chart the tendency to accident is still more marked. The more prominent they are, and the more heavily afflicted, the more certain to attract accident, and the more severe the accidents. That is, I believe we are safe in judging the liability of a person to accidental injury by considering the prominence and afflictions of Mars, Uranus and Saturn in the birth-chart.

Of the progressed aspects, the aspects to Mars, especially the afflictions to Mars, seem most to attract accidents, those to Saturn seem next in power to attract accidents, and those of Uranus only a little less powerful than those of Saturn. This does not signify that accidents result each time an affliction to one of these malefics occur by progression. If the birth-chart does not have the planet thus aspected by progression prominent, the progressed aspect is not likely to bring any serious accident, and perhaps no accident. But if the malefic is prominent in the birth-chart, the danger is much greater.

If the birth-chart strongly enough predisposes to accident, as shown by very prominent positions of the three malefics, and their severe afflictions, an accident can occur when there is no progression to them, and even no progression to the ruler of the 1st. An affliction by progression to some other planet in the chart, in such an unusually afflicted birth-chart, may be sufficient to cause accidental injury, as indicated in the 5 charts in which there were no aspects by progression to Mars, Uranus or Saturn.

The most constant factor in accidents is a progression to the ruler of the 1st. The first house rules the body. A progression to the ruler of the 1st, therefore, may be expected, more often than the aspect by progression to any other planet, to affect the body. But if the birth-chart strongly in-

dicates accident, or if the progressed affliction to one of the three malefics considered is unusually severe, an accident can take place when there is no progressed aspect to the ruler of the 1st. This happened in 9% of the charts considered. But in 91% of the charts there was a progressed aspect to the ruler of the 1st, and in 85% of the charts this progressed aspect to the ruler of the 1st was an affliction.

A good aspect of the Moon by progression may bring certain favors at the time, but has very little power to prevent accident. In 29% of the cases the Moon was making good aspects by progression. It may be that the accidents would have been more severe in some cases if the progressed Moon had made an affliction. But in other cases, which resulted in death, the good aspects of the progressed Moon can not be shown to have ameliorated the accident.

In all the cases here considered in which death resulted from the accident, there was also a progressed aspect to the ruler of the 8th.

Many of the severe accidents here considered were the result of taking undue hazards. Both the birth-chart prominence of the three mentioned malefics and the progressed aspect to one or more of them, created a desire to take the unusual hazard. It is highly probable that a large percentage of the accidents here tabulated could have been avoided by the individuals had they received, and acted upon, the advice of some competent astrologer. Extra care taken during dangerous periods, as proved over and over again, enables the individual to pass through the period without injury.

But in order that the astrologer may be able to give competent advice he must possess sufficient information not to admonish caution whenever any little progressed affliction comes along; for excessive caution is wasteful of energy, and prevents what otherwise might be accomplished.

If, however, the birth-chart shows a tendency to accident, due to the prominence of Mars, Uranus, or Saturn; and a severe affliction to one of these three planets forms by progression; and at the same time there is an affliction to the ruler of the Ascendant; advice as to caution may be given with the certainty that such warning is fully warranted by the conditions.
