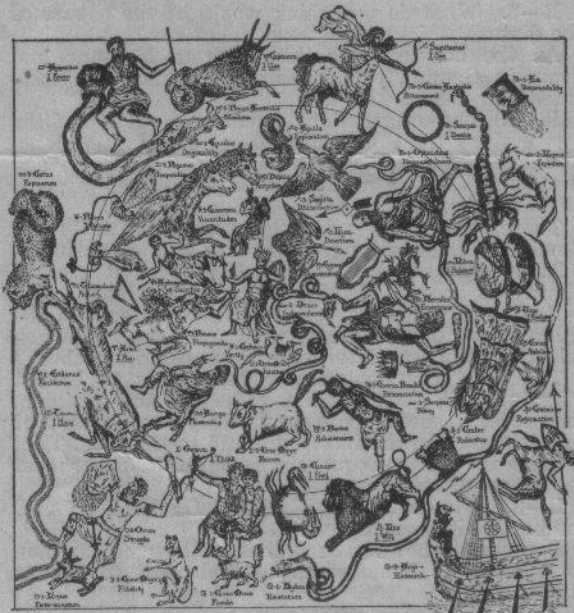
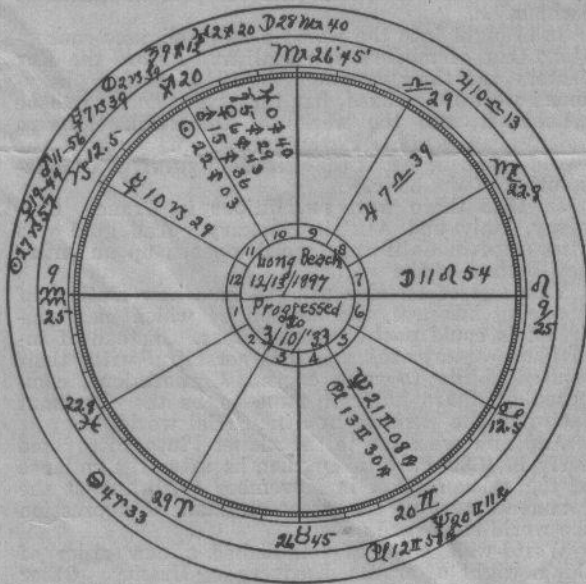

M-36. In the Neptune Cycle, Neptune makes the trine to Pluto r Nov. 3 and again Jan. 21, 1933. Neptune rules socialism, and world-wide schemes. Do you think within a week of these dates there will be plans affecting international relations, and demonstrations of a socialistic nature?

No. 7: "Hoover declares Hearst opposed to Disarmament Conference now in progress." Nov. 6: "Importations from Philippines will be restricted." Nov. 7: "Hitler Nazi Wave Broken by German Election."

Jan. 19: "Hoover joins Roosevelt in Far East Study." Jan. 19: "League Probes Charge of Secret Fortifying Near U. S. Pacific Isles."

M-37. Uranus rules communism and radical activities. It has been retrograde for some months, but turns direct in motion December 29. Do you think radical activities and mob gatherings will increase markedly after December 29?

Jan. 1: "Hoover Group Asks Social Planning as Remedy for Unrest; Violent Revolution Possible if Peril Ignored." Jan. 3: "Gas Quells 500 Rioters Trying to Storm Bowl."

M-38. In the Saturn Cycle, Saturn comes trine Saturn r in the 8th, house of money due us, on Jan. 17, 1933. Do you think the matter of debt settlement will again assume importance within a few days of this date?

Jan. 17: "U. S. Will Slash Private Debts." Jan. 18: "Buy American Spreads Over Nation." Jan. 18: "U. S. Exports for 1932 Set Lowest Mark in 27 Years."

Religion of the Stars Constellation Chart.—Pictures all the 48 ancient constellations correctly, and in minute detail. The name of the constellation is given, together with the Key-word of the sign or decanate it pictures. By means of a number and the symbol of the zodiacal sign to which it belongs, the particular decanate of the zodiac pictured by each of the 36 ultra-zodiacal constellations is clearly shown.

M-39. In the 1932 Ingress Cycle, the Sun comes trine Uranus r and Mercury r Dec. 10. As Mercury rules the house of money, do you think there will be important financial developments within one day of this date?

Dec. 11: "England Will Pay \$95,550,000 Dec. 15; But It Will Be the Last." Dec. 11: "U. S. Will Insist On Unconditional Payment of War Debts."

R-7. In the chart here published (female, December Quarterly), do you think this woman to be subject to wasting diseases?

(Chart 1562) Yes, the affliction of Moon from Neptune and Pluto, especially in mutable signs, tends to wasting diseases.

R-8. What do you think would be the nature of the disease which would most afflict her?

As the heaviest affliction is from Neptune and Pluto in Gemini, tuberculosis of the lungs is indicated..

R-9. The progressions around the outside of the figure show the Sun square Mars r, Mars conjunction Neptune p, and Venus afflicting both Mars r and the Sun p. How would these progressed aspects affect her health?

These progressed afflictions were most severe in Gemini, ruling the lungs, and after a short period in a Sanatorium she died Jan. 26, 1932, with progressed planets as shown, of tuberculosis of the lungs.

B-7. If you were called upon to determine the value of various religions, what one test would you select by which to determine which religion is best?

The chief function of any religion is to benefit mankind. In judging the value of any religion, therefore, it should be appraised by the amount of its assistance to the individual and to the race. That religion is best, consequently, which contributes most to universal welfare.

B-8. Why is THE RELIGION OF THE STARS the best religion in the world?

Because it shows each individual how he can live so as most to benefit himself and most to benefit others.

B-9. Briefly, in what ways is THE RELIGION OF THE STARS superior to all other religions?

It is more helpful than any other religion because it enables man to know more about himself, to know more about other entities and forces in the universe, to understand the proper relation of man to other men and to other entities, and because it enables him to utilize this knowledge to advance himself and benefit others. It places before man a truer and more comprehensive knowledge of the purpose of the universe and the proper function of his soul in it; and gives him the information by which he can be of maximum use both to himself and to others.

He helps himself most when he most assists others, and to be able thus to assist others he must advance his own real interests as much as possible.

But he can neither gain correct knowledge of the relations mentioned, nor apply this information effectively, unless he is conversant with astrology: Astrology is both the key to a correct philosophy of life and at the same time the most potent aid to right living. Hence we call our religion, THE RELIGION OF THE STARS.

The Plutonian Age.—As astrology is entirely based upon the sympathy which exists between the things which are on earth and the orbs of heaven, which causes movements to occur on earth which parallel those in the sky, no point is to be made by stressing the Law of Correspondences.

Yet the correspondences which exist between the discovery of a new planet in the sky and the discovery of new methods on the earth have not received the attention they warrant.

Uranus, the planet of invention and of independence, was discovered in 1781, and may rightly be said to have ushered in the machine age, and the age of republics.

The looms of England rapidly transform her from an agricultural into an industrial nation. Engines of all kinds come into use, one invention following another. Still later, electricity adds its power to this age of manufacture.

In 1782 the Peace of Versailles and Paris grants an independent existence to the United States. This sets a precedent, to be followed by most of the countries of the New World. The Republican form of Government came to be a dominant factor in all the Western Hemisphere.

Neptune was discovered in 1846 ushering in the age of oil and gas; which prepared the way for our present industrial system and our present means of locomotion.

It brought into the world a new religious conception; that of modern spiritualism. Before the Fox Sisters and their rappings, in 1848, similar phenomena were recognized, but they were deemed to be witchcraft, and the works of the devil. Modern spiritualism had its birth in 1848, and gave to the world scientific proof that the soul survives the dissolution of the body.

In 1848 there were revolutions in France, Germany, Italy and Austria-Hungary. And gold was discovered in California, which opened up an entire new section of the world.

This age of oil also ushered in a new method of financing business, the method by which many individuals could pool their resources. Instead of individual enterprise, and partnerships, with their limited ability to raise capital, Corporations, composed of share holders, came to be the dominant factor in the business and industrial world.

And now we come to the planet Pluto, discovered early in 1930, only a few months after the collapse of the stock market in November 1929, and at the commencement of the greatest financial depression the world has ever known.

World-wide changes established a new order of things right after the discovery of Uranus. Other world-wide changes established still a different, and more complex, order of things immediately after Neptune was first sighted. Are we to believe, then, that the present great changes in the world have no relation to the discovery of Pluto?

Methods which were too slow for the Uranian vibratory rate perished soon after Uranus came to be recognized. And the order of things which sufficed well enough before Neptune was discovered was unable to survive after the Neptunian influence came well into power.

And all those things—the old methods of doing business, the old type of politics, the old financial system, and the orthodox religions— are being knocked to pieces right now by the high vibrations of Pluto. Anything; even occult organizations, which can not make a marked change from old methods to get into step with the new speed of the world; will be shaken to pieces.

Of all the planets able most effectively to assist in such a shattering process, the planet Uranus is most potent.

And shortly after the discovery of Pluto, Uranus makes the square aspect to Pluto five distinct times. Three of these have already passed. Did they shatter things?

The first square of Uranus to Pluto occurred April 21, 1932. In the Far East Japan decides to acquire Manchuria by Military aggression. In Europe a financial crisis arises with open threat of bankruptcy on the part of Germany with a possibility of revolution. In the U. S. to avert the threatened condition in Europe, Hoover declared a moratorium on the June payments due this country, thus setting a precedent and greatly deepening the depression in the U. S.

The second square of Uranus to Pluto occurred Sept. 3, 1932. In Europe the League of Nations tells

Japan to get out of Manchuria. It the Far East Japan tells the League to mind its own business, and continues her policy of taking just what she wants. In the United States, Bonus Marchers in Washington are fired upon, one is killed, their shelters are burned. They are driven from Washington like starving cattle.

The third square of Uranus to Pluto occurred March 8, 1933. In the Far East Japan withdraws from the League of Nations and starts the invasion of China. In Europe, Hitler becomes the dictator of Germany, and a campaign of persecution is launched against the Jews; and the other religions are compelled to make revisions to suit the dictator. In the U. S. all the banks in the country are closed for about two weeks.

There are still two more squares of Uranus to Pluto to come. Do you think that these squares will pass without great disturbances?

An eastern astrologer has computed the place of Pluto in 1776 as Aquarius 16-39. We have not the means of verifying this. But if it is correct, the progressed Sun in the chart of the U. S. which we use, as given on frontispiece of lesson No. 141, with 7 degrees Gemini rising, came to the trine aspect to Pluto in the 10th house in March 1933.

Jupiter is the financial planet, and we do know that in the Jupiter Cycle chart for the U. S., the planet Jupiter made the sextile aspect to Pluto in the 10th house, the house of business, on the last day of March, 1933.

The "New Deal" which was inaugurated under these favorable aspects has all the indications that the U. S., beginning with the present administration, has been successful in raising her methods to the higher rate of the planet Pluto. And as a further omen of success, in this attempt to get in step with the better side of Pluto, it should be noted that the progressed Sun will make the trine aspect to the Moon r, in the 10th house of the U. S. chart in about a year from now.

From these and other astrological considerations I am led to believe that the U. S. is being successful in making the necessary adjustment, and that while the next two aspects of Uranus to Pluto will bring their problems, that they will be met in an eminently satisfactory manner.

But I can not say as much regarding either Europe or the Far East.

The next square from Uranus to Pluto occurs Nov. 6, 1933.

The last square from Uranus to Pluto occurs Jan. 13, 1934.

These aspects indicate crises of great importance the coming winter, both in Europe and the Far East. They point to still further changes in both regions.

And because Saturn is now passing through Aquarius, ruler of Russia, the great White Bear will hardly be a passive spectator. As this is written a four-power pact has been signed, binding the other four important European powers to keep the peace for at least ten years. Yet in spite of this pact, upheavals will occur, and armed conflict can be averted only through the exercise of unusual diplomatic skill.

All of which has been said to indicate the passing of the old order and the coming of the new.

Nor will the changes in regard to philosophy and religion be less drastic. Already Mexico, Spain and Germany have taken drastic steps in such matters.

And although these changes have not been as progressive as we might wish; and have even been marked by deplorable events; yet they show that the old order is passing.

The intelligent of this new order, much more rapidly than you may suppose, are moving surely in a direction that will ultimately cause them to embrace as their philosophy of life, THE RELIGION OF THE STARS.

A Token Received by the Panama Center.—A letter, dated Cristobal, C.Z., Nov. 18, 1932, is as follows:

Dear Church of Light Brethren: I take pleasure in giving the details of an unusual event which took place on the 24th day of September, 1932, at about 5:00 a.m., to brother G. S. Haywood.

In the day and time mentioned he heard the fluttering of a bird which he mistook for a night-bat. He made an attempt to strike it but quickly declined from so doing. He lit some incense with the thought that this visitor was of an evil nature. It kept quiet during the time the incense was burning. Then the bird began to fly about again and landed on one of the doors of his room. He caught it. It was a beautiful canary.

After returning from work, about 5:00 p.m., Mr. Haywood began to make a cage for the bird, working at it until about 7:00 p.m.

By this time information of the matter had reached our brother, C. Bowen, who made psychic inquiry as to whether the visitor was one to be welcomed or not. The word he received from the inner plane was that the bird had been sent to notify G. S. Haywood of a death, either of a member of his family, or of a member of The Church of Light Center.

An order was also received that the bird be released at once. This was done as commanded, and eight days later brother George A. Cray, of our Church of Light Center, was drowned. Signed, R. Richards, Secretary, Colon Center No. 1, Panama.

Charts of Dogs, Cats and Horses.—As exponents of The Religion of The Stars, we believe we should encourage those who pioneer in the attempt to widen the field of usefulness of astrology.

Several of our acquaintances in the past have made a practice of erecting the birth-charts of domestic pets, especially of cats. And these have claimed to be able to tell much about the cat-fortune from the cat birth-chart.

Another student, the wife of a man who made a profession of raising and running race horses, followed the practice of erecting the birth-chart of every colt they raised or ran.

She said she had found that the ability and chances of success of a horse could be determined from its birth-chart just as accurately as the ability and trend of life of a man could so be determined.

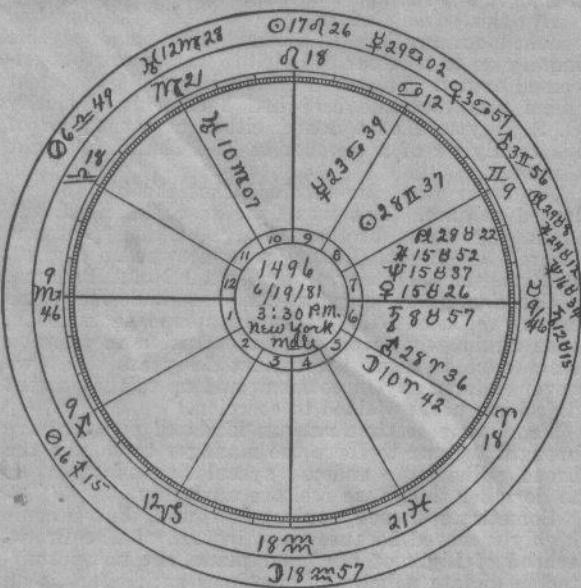
And now our good friend Regina S. Thomas, with a true pioneering spirit, backed by unusual ability, is bringing astrology to the attention of dog fanciers.

Natal Astrology Questions.—Chart 1496, here published, is that of a man high in public office, whose name will be given in the next issue of the quarterly. The major progressions shown around the outside of the chart are for Aug. 15, 1932.

N—20. During 1930 and 1931 the Sun was making the square to Venus r, Neptune r and Jupiter r, in the 7th house (partners and enemies). The square of the Sun to Neptune p in the 7th was still operative in the fall of 1932, and the Sun at the same time was conjunction the M.C. (honor), but still in the 9th (courts) house. What event occurred in August and September, 1932?

N—21. In 1933 the Sun is parallel Neptune p in the 7th, and in March the progressed Moon came square to Pluto in the 7th, and sextile Mars r and trine Sun r. What event took place at this time?

N—22. In April, 1933, the progressed Sun making the parallel to Neptune in the 7th, and the Moon progressed to sesqui-square Mercury in the 9th (legal matters), what event took place?

Conclusions About Typhoid Fever.—The first house rules the body. And even as Report No. 14 indicates that the most constant factor in accidents is a progressed aspect to the ruler of the first, so it would seem that the most constant factor in typhoid fever, and possibly in all illness, is some progressed aspect to the ruler of the first house.

Illness is some definite affliction of the body, such as comes under the jurisdiction of the sixth house. Often the progressed aspect to the ruler of the sixth is weak and not at all obvious, for it may be a parallel; but in all the cases here considered there is some progressed aspect, not including the progressions of the Moon, which is within the one degree of perfection which is the limit of orb allowed in these reports.

In these cases certainly, and possibly in all illness, a progressed aspect to the ruler of the sixth is also a constant factor. And a study of the charts here considered indicates that, other things being equal, a progressed affliction to the ruler of the sixth is more potent to attract illness than a progressed affliction to the ruler of the first.

This does not signify that an affliction to the first or an affliction to the sixth, or both, inevitably brings illness. The illness is usually indicated by some severe affliction which may, or may not, involve the first and sixth. But if illness results from the affliction, some progressed aspect to the ruler of the first and to the ruler of the sixth seems necessary—even a good progressed aspect—to direct the astrological energies into channels which weaken the health.

Of the three charts in which there was no progressed aspect to Mars at the time of the typhoid fever, in one Mars was in the sixth, and the progressed Moon was in the sixth in opposition to Venus. In another there was a severe affliction to Mars in the birth-chart, and the progressed Moon was parallel Mars. And in the third Mars was in the sixth, afflicted by the progressed Moon.

In the two birth-charts in which Mars was only slightly afflicted at birth, the sixth house was badly afflicted otherwise, and in each instance there was a

progressed affliction to Mars at the time of the illness.

In the seven charts in which the progressed aspect to Mars which coincided with the illness was a good aspect, Mars was notably afflicted in the birth-chart, so that the influence of the progressed aspect had little power to benefit, yet attracted Mars conditions.

The aspects of the progressed Moon indicate that when the heavier progressions point to illness, that good progressions of the Moon, while attracting certain favors during the illness, do not prevent it. One can acquire typhoid fever almost as readily when the Moon by progression makes only good aspects as when it makes only bad aspects.

The unavoidable conclusion, drawn from this analysis, is that a severely afflicted Mars in the birth-chart predisposes to typhoid fever, and that the time when such illness is attracted is when there is a progressed aspect to Mars, especially a progressed affliction to Mars, and when the aspects otherwise, such as to the rulers of the first and sixth, point to ill health. Typhoid fever is strictly a Mars disease.

Progressed Chart of Long Beach.—In the birth-chart of Los Angeles (lesson No. 141) at the time of the earthquake, March 10, 1933, the planet Venus, ruler of the Ascendant, had reached, by major progression, the square to Uranus in the 9th.

The progressed Venus was in the 5th house, ruling schools, and the chief damage in Los Angeles was to school houses, these being of brick, and of poor construction. Many school buildings were condemned, and school children were inconvenienced by not being able to attend classes.

Venus is rather a mild planet, and the amount of damage done, which was more serious in the adverse advertising (advertising is ruled by the 9th) received than in damage to life or property, is about what one would expect from a square progression from Venus.

The situation was far more serious in Long Beach, the birth-chart of which, with the progressions around the outside, is given on the front page.

In the birth-chart the Sun is heavily afflicted by the conjunction of Mars and the opposition of Neptune. Pluto is in the 4th house, ruling lands and buildings, and at the time of the earthquake the Sun, by major progression, had come exactly to the sesqui-square aspect to Pluto. This affected the buildings.

The Moon, significator of large numbers of people, is in the 7th, but is ruler of the 6th, house of illness. Mars, the planet of violence, had progressed exactly to the inconjunct aspect to the Moon, at the time of the earthquake, showing damage to many persons.

Mercury, co-ruler of the house of death, had progressed to the square of Jupiter in the 8th (house of death). This coincided with the heavy loss of life.

Finally, the Moon had moved, by major progression into the 10th house, and had come to the sextile of the Sun. This house position of the Moon gave the matter the widest publicity, and the good aspect made by the Moon brought prompt and efficient relief to those in distress.
